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Message from the Minister

The Ministry under my responsibility is committed towards combatting gender-based violence and domestic violence through the strengthening of legal measures and policy development, together with the enhancement of the services provided. This is all being performed in the framework of the Istanbul Convention of the Council of Europe that Malta signed and ratified in 2014.

Over the last years, this Government adopted various initiatives and implemented a number of measures aimed at addressing gender-based violence and domestic violence. Particularly in the initial stages of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, I ensured that strengthening and reinforcing the work related to Gender-based Violence and Domestic Violence Action was placed high on the agenda.

I also note that in 2020 Ms. Audrey Friggieri was appointed as the first full-time Commissioner on Gender-based and Domestic Violence, and this highlighted the Government's aim of eliminating the social plague of gender-based and domestic violence. Moreover, many other initiatives were taken, namely:

- The introduction of 24/7 free legal assistance for all victims by the Legal Aid Agency;
- The setting up of the Gender-based and Domestic Unit Violence within the Malta Police Force to ensure that persons filing a report on domestic violence receive immediate attention and protection;
- Various awareness-raising campaigns targeting the general public;
- The yearly commitment in commemorating the '16 Days of Activism' campaign by the United Nations, which last year was held under the distinguished patronage of Dr Lydia Abela, spouse of the Prime Minister.

The 2021-2022 National Strategy on Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence shall continue consolidating the hard work achieved from the first-ever national strategy of 2018-2020.

This new strategy aims to keep on implementing the recommendations of the Group of Experts on Action against Violence against Women and Domestic Violence (GREVIO), which were agreed upon with the focal points from various Ministries sitting on the Inter-Ministerial Committee for the implementation of the enclosed action plan.

Through this 2021-2022 National Strategy, together with the Parliamentary Secretary for Civil Liberties and Reforms, Rosianne Cutajar, I shall continue overseeing the developments in the fight against gender-based violence and domestic violence. I hereby also recognise the holistic efforts of the Maltese Government through the work of its various Ministries functioning in the established Inter-Ministerial Committee.

I conclude by reaffirming my position on the importance of the continuous implementation of reforms which this Ministry is synonymous with, especially in the field of equality for all and in all aspects.

Messagġ mill-Ministru

Il-Ministeru taħt ir-responsabbiltà tiegħi huwa impenjat lejn il-ġlieda kontra l-vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u l-vjolenza domestika permezz tat-tisħiħ ta' miżuri legali u l-iżvilupp ta' politika, flimkien mat-tisħiħ tas-servizzi pprovduti. Dan kollu qed jittwettaq fil-qafas tal-Konvenzjoni ta' Istanbul tal-Kunsill tal-Ewropa li Malta ffirmat u rratifikat fl-2014.

Matul dawn l-aħħar snin, dan il-Gvern adotta diversi inizjattivi u implimenta għadd ta' miżuri mmirati lejn l-indirizzar ta' vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u vjolenza domestika. B'mod partikolari fl-istadji inizjali tal-pandemija tal-COVID-19 fl-2020, jiena żgurajt li t-tisħiħ u l-infurzar tal-ħidma relatata mal-Azzjoni fir-rigward tal-Vjolenza abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika jittqiegħdu fuq quddiem nett fl-aġenda.

Jiena ninnota wkoll li fl-2020, is-Sinjura Audrey Friggieri għet maħtura bħala l-ewwel Kummissarju full-time għall-Vjolenza abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika, u dan enfasizza l-għan tal-gvern li jelimina l-pjaga soċjali tal-vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u l-vjolenza domestika. Barra minn hekk, ittiegħdu diversi inizjattivi oħra, b'mod partikolari:

- *L-introduzzjoni ta' assistenza legali 24 siegħa kuljum, mingħajr ħlas, għall-vittmi kollha mill-Aġenzija għall-Għajnuna Legali;*
- *It-twaqqif ta' Taqsima għall-Vjolenza abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika fi ħdan il-Forza tal-Pulizija ta' Malta biex ikun żgurat li persuni li jagħmlu rapport dwar vjolenza domestika jirċievu attenzjoni u protezzjoni immedjata;*
- *Diversi kampanji għarfien immirati lejn il-pubbliku ġenerali;*
- *L-impenn ta' kull sena b'tifkira tal-kampanja "16-il Jum ta' Attiviżmu" min-Nazzjonijiet Uniti, li s-sena l-oħra għet organizzata taħt il-patroċinju distint ta' Dr Lydia Abela, il-mara tal-Prim Ministru.*

L-Istrateġija Nazzjonali dwar il-Vjolenza abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika għall-2021-2022 għandha tkompli tikkonsolida x-xogħol siewi li nkiseb mill-ewwel strateġija nazzjonali tal-2018-2020.

Din l-istrateġija l-ġdida għandha l-għan li tkompli timplimenta r-rakkomandazzjonijiet tal-Grupp ta' Esperti dwar l-Azzjoni kontra l-Vjolenza fuq in-Nisa u l-Vjolenza Domestika (GREVIO), li ġew miftiehma mal-punti fokali mid-diversi Ministeri li jiffurmaw il-Kumitat Inter-Ministerjali għall-implimentazzjoni tal-pjan ta' azzjoni meħmuż.

Permezz ta' din l-Istrateġija Nazzjonali għall-2021-2022, flimkien mas-Segretarju Parlamentari għal-Libertajiet Ċivili u r-Riformi, Rosianne Cutajar, jiena se nkompli nissorvelja l-iżviluppi fil-ġlieda kontra l-vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u l-vjolenza domestika. Jiena hawnhekk nirrikonoxxi wkoll l-isforzi olistiċi tal-Gvern Malti permezz tal-ħidma tad-diversi Ministeri tiegħu li jiffunzjonaw fil-Kumitat Inter-Ministerjali stabbilit.

Jiena nikkonkludi billi nafferma mill-ġdid il-pożizzjoni tiegħi dwar l-importanza tal-implimentazzjoni kontinwa ta' riformi li dan il-Ministeru huwa assoċjat magħhom, b'mod speċjali fil-qasam tal-ugwaljanza għal kulħadd u fl-aspetti kollha.

Message from Dr. Lydia Abela

A strategy is paramount for every aspect of policymaking. A plan is needed to give direction and set aims and deliverables. A successful process requires not only clear vision but also good implementation.

However, this particular strategy needs something more. It needs love and compassion in its implementation.

In my experience, working closely with victims of domestic violence, there is one element which is more important than anything else — a successful service depends on how the person dealing with the victim uses their heart as much as their mind.

When I visited the Malta Police Force's specialised unit some months ago, I could see that while the increased investment had had a really positive impact, it was the team's sensitivity which had made a significant difference for those individuals passing through a difficult moment.

Domestic violence victims are not mere statistics. They need efficient access to services with a one-stop-shop approach. The streamlining of Legal Aid, Appoġġ and the Malta Police Force's services through the signature of a memorandum of understanding has been a crucial development.

The launch of a specialised, free, 24/7 legal assistance service for such victims, through Legal Aid Malta and the enhanced national helpline 179, is further evidence that our country is dealing with this challenge in a most effective way.

But in a dynamic society, experiencing constant change, the authorities should not rest on their laurels, and that is why publishing an updated strategy is the correct thing to do.

This second national strategy highlights the Maltese Government's effort to address the reality of gender-based and domestic violence in Malta through effective policy and tangible action.

This strategy aims at putting forward policy measures based on several GREVIO recommendations while upholding the four pillars established by the Istanbul Convention: prevention, protection, prosecution, and integrated policies on Gender-Based Violence (GBV) and Domestic Violence (DV).

The strategy includes the development of research on children witnessing or experiencing domestic violence, action to better understand the operational aspects of the justice system for victims of GBV and DV, as well as providing specialised training programmes for professionals based on training needs analysis with relevant stakeholders.

It also emphasises the need for multi-agency, multi-disciplinary cooperation and collaboration between governmental and non-governmental entities so as to strengthen services that address this phenomenon.

I look forward to the implementation of this strategy as I have no doubt that it will be meaningful to people's lives.

The more love we put into the delivery of this strategy, the greater the results will be. The legacy shall be a country which addresses the social realities of hundreds of people, sensitively and intelligently.

Strategġija hija ta' importanza kbira għal kull aspett tat-tfassil tal-politika. Pjan huwa meħtieġ sabiex jagħti direzzjoni u jstabbilixxi għanijiet u riżultati. Proċess li jirnexxi jirrikjedi mhux biss viżjoni ċara, iżda anke implimentazzjoni tajba.

Madankollu, din l-istrategġija partikolari teħtieġ xi haġa oħra. Teħtieġ l-imħabba u l-kompassjoni fl-implimentazzjoni tagħha.

Fl-esperjenza tiegħi, fejn ħdimt mill-qrib ma' vittmi ta' vjolenza domestika, hemm element wieħed li huwa aktar importanti minn kwalunwe haġa oħra – servizz li jirnexxi jiddependi fuq kif il-persuna li qed tittratta mal-vittma tuża qalbha daqskemm tuża moħħha.

Meta żort it-taqsima speċjalizzata tal-Korp tal-Pulizija ta' Malta f'tit xhur ilu, stajt nara li, filwaqt li ż-żieda fl-investment kellha impatt verament pożittiv, kienet is-sensittività tat-tim li għamlet differenza sinifikanti għal dawk l-individwi li kienu għaddejjin minn mument diffiċli.

Il-vittmi ta' vjolenza domestika mhumiex sempliċement parti minn statistika. Huma jeħtieġu aċċess effiċjenti għal servizzi b'approċċ ta' one-stop-shop. Is-simplifikazzjoni tas-servizzi tal-Għajnuna Legali, l-Aġenzija Appoġġ u l-Korp tal-Pulizija ta' Malta permezz tal-iffirmar ta' memorandum ta' qbil kien żvilupp kruċjali.

It-tnedija ta' servizz ta' għajnuna legali speċjalizzata, bla ħlas u miftuħ 24 siegħa kuljum għal dawn il-vittmi, permezz ta' Għajnuna Legali Malta u l-helpline nazzjonali mtejjeb 179, huwa prova ulterjuri li pajjiżna qed jindirizza din l-isfida b'mod mill-aktar effettiv.

Madankollu, f'soċjetà dinamika, li tesperjenza bidla kostanti, l-awtoritajiet m'għandhomx jistrieħu fuq il-kisbiet tagħhom, u għalhekk, il-pubblikazzjoni ta' strategġija aġġornata hija l-aħjar haġa li tista' ssir.

Din it-tieni strategġija nazzjonali tenfasizza l-isforz tal-Gvern Malti li jindirizza r-realtà tal-vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u l-vjolenza domestika f'Malta permezz ta' politika effettiva u azzjoni tanġibbli.

Din l-istrategġija għandha l-għan li tressaq miżuri ta' politika bbażati fuq diversi rakkomandazzjonijiet tal-GREVIO, filwaqt li tosserva l-erba' pilastrji stabbiliti mill-Konvenzjoni ta' Istanbul: il-prevenzjoni, il-protezzjoni, il-prosekuzzjoni u l-politiki integrati dwar il-Vjolenza Abbażi tal-Ġeneru (GBV-Gender-Based Violence) u l-Vjolenza Domestika (DV-Domestic Violence).

L-istrategġija tinkludi l-iżvilupp ta' riċerka dwar tfal li jesperjenzaw jew ikunu xhieda ta' vjolenza domestika, azzjoni biex jiġu mifhuma aħjar l-aspetti operattivi tas-sistema ġudizzjarja għal vittmi ta' vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u vjolenza domestika, kif ukoll tipprovdni programmi ta' taħriġ speċjalizzati għal professjonisti bbażati fuq l-analiżi tal-ħtiġijiet tat-taħriġ ma' partijiet interessati rilevanti.

Tenfasizza wkoll il-ħtieġa għal kooperazzjoni u kollaborazzjoni multidixxiplinari u bejn diversi aġenziji, bejn entitajiet governattivi u mhux governattivi, sabiex jissafħu s-servizzi li jindirizzaw dan il-fenomeno.

Jiena nistenna bil-ħerqa l-implimentazzjoni ta' din l-istrategġija għaliex m'għandix dubju li se tkun verament sinifikanti għall-ħajjiet tan-nies.

Aktar ma nwasslu din l-istrategġija b'imħabba, aktar seniksbu riżultati. Il-legat għandu jkun pajjiż li jindirizza r-realtajiet soċjali ta' mijiet ta' persuni, b'sensittività u intelliġenza.

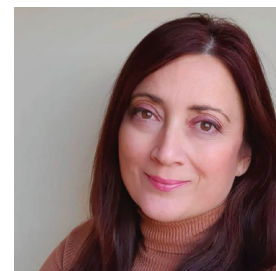
Message from the Commissioner

Messagġ mill-Kummissarju

Il-Kummissjoni dwar il-Vjolenza abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika hija impenjata li ssaħħaħ l-implimentazzjoni tal-Konvenzjoni ta' Istanbul fil-ġlieda kontra l-forom kollha ta' vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u vjolenza domestika. It-tibdil fil-mod kif ngħixu li rriżulta mill-pandemija tal-coronavirus wassal biex inkunu aktar sensittivi minn qatt qabel għall-periklu li persuni f'relazzjonijiet abbużivi jistgħu jkunu fih minħabba li jqattgħu aktar ħin vicin min jabbużahom. L-importanza li jiġu protetti persuni li qed jgħixu f'relazzjonijiet abbużivi u li nħabirku biex neliminaw il-vjolenza domestika darba għal dejjem qatt ma nħasset b'mod daqshekk profond.

Matul dan iż-żmien ta' sfida, il-Kummissjoni hija kuntenta li bdiet u ppartecipat f'diversi inizjattivi mmirati lejn is-salvagwardja ta' familji, gruppi u individwi f'riskju ta' vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u vjolenza domestika. Nixtieq nirringrazzja lill-entitajiet kollha tal-gvern u lill-NGOs li qed jaħdmu fil-qasam tal-vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u l-vjolenza domestika għad-dedikazzjoni tagħhom fit-tisħiħ ta' proceduri ta' servizzi u l-aġġustament tagħhom b'tali mod li, filwaqt li jiġu rrispettati l-miżuri ta' sikurezza, daww kollha li jfittxu l-għajjnuna jistgħu jirċevuha b'mod effettiv.

Din l-istrateġija u dan il-pjan ta' azzjoni għall-perjodu ta' 2021-2022 se jservu biex isaħħu u jibnu fuq l-istrutturi fis-seħħ li jindirizzaw l-erba' pilastri tal-Konvenzjoni ta' Istanbul b'tali mod li l-fenomeni tal-vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u l-vjolenza domestika f'Malta jiġi indirizzat b'mod konsistenti u olistiku. Dan jinkludi t-tfassil ta' programmi ffokati li huma mmirati lejn l-involvement ma' awturi tar-reat u l-indirizzar tal-attitudnijiet u l-imġiba ta' ħsara tagħhom.

Nixtiequ nagħmluha ċara fil-pajjiż tagħna li l-vjolenza mhijjex kwistjoni privata u li taffettwa lis-soċjetà kollha. Aħna nixtiequ wkoll inħabirku lejn koordinazzjoni u kooperazzjoni bejn diversi aġenziji biex niżguraw li n-nies isibu u jirċievu l-għajjnuna li jeħtieġu meta jfittxuha. Jeħtieġ li kollha kemm aħna nivvizzwalizzaw u naħdmu lejn soċjetà fejn kulhadd iħossu sikur għalix jaf li d-drittijiet tal-bniedem fundamentali huma rrispettati.

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A. Introduction

Malta's first national strategy to address gender-based violence and domestic violence brought together a number of government ministries and entities as well as non-governmental organisations with a focus on strengthening legal and policy measures and service provision for persons experiencing such violence. The 2018-2020 strategy was built on the four pillars of the Istanbul Convention: (i) prevention, (ii) protection, (iii) prosecution and (iv) integrated policies. Therefore, policy measures were developed to strengthen the need for coordination among the various stakeholders; the effective protection of victims and solid awareness-raising campaigns targeting the general public.

In 2019, Malta submitted its first country report to the Group of Experts on Action against Violence against Women and Domestic Violence (GREVIO), which is the international body responsible for monitoring the implementation of the Istanbul Convention in all State Parties. A visit by the GREVIO delegation took place in February 2020 as part of the evaluation process. The final GREVIO recommendations for Malta were published on the Council of Europe's website in November 2020. These recommendations ensure that Malta will continue its commitment towards the implementation of the Istanbul Convention through legislation, policy and service provision.

A. Introduzzjoni

L-ewwel strateġija nazzjonali ta' Malta biex jiġu indirizzati l-vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u l-vjolenza domestika għabet flimkien għadd ta' ministeri u entitajiet tal-gvern kif ukoll organizzazzjonijiet mhux governattivi b'fokus fuq it-tisħiħ ta' miżuri legali u politiċi u l-provvediment ta' servizz għal persuni li jesperjenzaw vjolenza bħal din. L-istrateġija tal-2018-2020 kienet mibnija fuq l-erba' pilastru tal-Konvenzjoni ta' Istanbul: (i) il-prevenzjoni, (ii) il-protezzjoni, (iii) il-prosekuzzjoni u (iv) politiki integrati. Għalhekk, ġew żviluppatti miżuri ta' politika biex tissaħħaħ il-ħtieġa għal koordinazzjoni fost id-diversi partijiet interessati, il-protezzjoni effettiva ta' vittmi u kampanji t'għarfien solidi mmirati lejn il-pubbliku ġenerali.

Fl-2019, Malta ppreżentat l-ewwel rapport tal-pajjiż lill-Grupp ta' Esperti dwar l-Azzjoni kontra l-Vjolenza fuq in-Nisa u l-Vjolenza Domestika (GREVIO), li huwa l-korp internazzjonali responsabbli għall-monitoraġġ tal-implimentazzjoni tal-Konvenzjoni ta' Istanbul fl-Istati Partijiet kollha. Fi Frar tal-2020 saret żjara mid-delegazzjoni GREVIO bħala parti mill-proċess ta' evalwazzjoni. Ir-rakkomandazzjonijiet finali ta' GREVIO għal Malta ġew ippubblikati fuq is-sit elettroniku tal-Kunsill tal-Ewropa f'Novembru 2020. Dawn ir-rakkomandazzjonijiet jiżguraw li Malta tkompli bl-impenn tagħha lejn l-implimentazzjoni tal-Konvenzjoni ta' Istanbul permezz ta' leġislazzjoni, politika u provvediment ta' servizz.

Tnedija tal-ewwel strateġija nazzjonali

Malta's second national strategy '**The Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence Strategy and Action Plan 2021–2022**' was developed by the Commission on Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence in collaboration with the Interministerial Committee.

It-tieni strateġija nazzjonali ta' Malta "L-Istrateġija u l-Pjan ta' Azzjoni għall-2021–2022 dwar il-Vjolenza Abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika" giet żviluppata mill-Kummissjoni dwar il-Vjolenza Abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika f'kollaborazzjoni mal-Kumitat Interministerjali.

B. Coordination and Implementation

B1. The strategy implementation coordinator

The Commission on Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence is the coordinating body as stipulated by Article 10 of the Istanbul Convention. It is therefore tasked with coordinating, implementing, monitoring and evaluating policies to prevent and combat all forms of GBV and DV. It is also responsible for coordinating data, analysing and disseminating its results.

B2. The Interministerial Committee

The coordination and implementation of this strategy will be carried out by the focal points representative of the various ministries and entities. This committee is chaired by the Commission on Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence with representatives from the Human Rights Directorate (MJEG), the Department of Justice (MJEG), the Office of the Attorney General, the Malta Police Force (MHSE), the Department for Probation and Parole (MHSE), the Ministry for Health, the National School Support Services and the Directorate for Learning Assessment and Programmes (MFED), the Legal Aid Agency (MJEG), the Court Services Agency (MJEG) and the Foundation for Social Welfare Services (MFCS). These main stakeholders come together to discuss policy development and service provision as well as disseminate good practices for preventing GBV and DV and strengthening support services.

B. Koordinazzjoni u Implimentazzjoni

B1. Il-koordinatur tal-implimentazzjoni tal-istrateġija

Il-Kummissjoni dwar il-Vjolenza Abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika hija l-ewwel korp ta' koordinazzjoni kif stipulat mill-Artikolu 10 tal-Konvenzjoni ta' Istanbul. Għalhekk tingħata l-kompitu li tikkoordina, timplimenta, timmonitorja u tevalwa politiki li jipprevjenu u jiġġieldu kontra l-forom kollha ta' GBV u DV. Hija responsabbli wkoll għall-koordinazzjoni ta' data, u l-analiżi u t-tixrid tar-riżultati tagħha.

B2. Il-Kumitat Interministerjali

Il-koordinazzjoni u l-implimentazzjoni ta' din l-istrateġija se jitwettqu mill-punti fokali rappreżentattivi tad-diversi ministeri u entitajiet. B3. Implementation processes

The implementation, monitoring and evaluation of **'Society's Concern: Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence Strategy and Action Plan'** were carried out through the Interministerial Committee. As outlined in the strategy, the focal persons from the respective ministries and entities were contacted every quarter to report on the progress of the policy measures falling under their remit.

The Commission on Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence together with the Interministerial Committee will continue to coordinate the implementation of Malta's second national strategy for 2021–2022.

B3. Proċessi ta' implimentazzjoni

L-implimentazzjoni, il-monitoraġġ u l-evalwazzjoni ta' "It-Thassib tas-Socjetà: L-Istrategija u l-Pjan ta' Azzjoni dwar il-Vjolenza Abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika" twettqu permezz tal-Kumitat Interministerjali. Kif deskritt fl-istrategija, il-persuni fokali mill-ministeri u l-entitajiet rispettivi ġew ikkuntattjati kull tliet xhur biex jirrapportaw dwar il-progress tal-miżuri ta' politika li jaqgħu taħt il-mandat tagħhom.

Il-Kummissjoni dwar il-Vjolenza Abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika flimkien mal-Kumitat Interministerjali se tkompli tikkordina l-implimentazzjoni tat-tieni strategija nazzjonali ta' Malta għall-2021–2022.

C. Measures implemented during COVID

During the COVID-19 pandemic, whilst restrictive measures were being imposed, the Maltese Government was committed to continue the delivery of services for victims of gender-based violence and domestic violence. In response to the restrictive measures ordered by the Superintendent of Public Health on the 16th of March 2020, national services and services offered by NGOs needed to alter their service delivery.

The introduction of safety precautions brought about a shift from face-to-face interventions to phone and online contact to ensure the continued delivery of support services throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. The restrictive measures ordered also resulted in the closure of the Courts of Justice from the 16th of March till the end of June 2020. Nevertheless, the Courts were given the power to order the hearing of urgent cases which included cases of domestic violence. Moreover, risk assessments were still carried out by the domestic violence risk assessors at the police stations when a person filed a domestic violence report at the district stations. Alternatively, risk assessments were also carried online to ensure that preventive and safety measures were adhered to.

In order to address the heightened risk for victims of domestic violence who were trapped indoors with their abusers, new services were launched. The Legal Aid Agency introduced free 24/7 legal assistance specifically for victims of domestic violence. A Memorandum of Understanding was also signed between the Malta Police Force, the Legal Aid Agency and the Foundation for Social Welfare Services to ensure that victims of gender-based violence and domestic violence receive adequate psychosocial and legal services as well as the necessary protection. Moreover, the Ministry for Social Accommodation extended its Private Rent Housing Benefit Scheme to victims of domestic violence, thus giving them

B'reazzjoni għall-miżuri restrittivi ordnati mis-Supretendent tas-Saħħa Pubblika fis-16 ta' Marzu 2020, kien meħtieġ li servizzi nazzjonali u servizzi offruti minn NGOs ibiddlu l-provvista tas-servizz tagħhom.

L-introduzzjoni ta' prekawzjonijiet ta' sikurezza rriżultat f'bidla minn interventi wiċċ imb wiċċ għal kuntatt bit-telefon u onlajn biex tkun żgurata l-provvista kontinwa ta' servizzi ta' appoġġ matul il-pandemija tal-COVID-19. Il-miżuri restrittivi ordnati rriżultaw ukoll fl-għeluq tal-Qrati tal-Ġustizzja mis-16 ta' Marzu sal-aħħar ta' Ġunju 2020. Madankollu, il-Qrati ngħataw is-setgħa li jordnaw is-smiġħ ta' każijiet urġenti li kienu jinkludu każijiet ta' vjolenza domestika. Barra minn hekk, valutazzjonijiet tar-riskju xorta twettqu mill-assessuri tar-riskju ta' vjolenza domestika fl-istazzjonijiet tal-pulizija meta persuna għamlet rapport ta' vjolenza domestika fl-istazzjonijiet tad-distrett. B'mod alternattiv, twettqu wkoll valutazzjonijiet tar-riskju onlajn biex ikun żgurat li jiġu osservati miżuri preventivi u ta' sikurezza.

Sabiex jiġi indirizzat ir-riskju miżjud għall-vittmi ta' vjolenza domestika li kienu magħluqin għewwa ma' dawk li abbużawhom, tnieđu servizzi ġodda. L-Aġenzija għall-Għajnuna Legali introduċiet assistenza legali mingħajr ħlas 24 siegħa kuljum speċifikament għal vittmi ta' vjolenza domestika. Ġie ffirmat ukoll Memorandum ta' Qbil bejn il-Forza tal-Pulizija ta' Malta, l-Aġenzija għall-Għajnuna Legali u l-Fondazzjoni għal Servizzi ta' Assistenza Soċjali biex ikun żgurat li l-vittmi ta' vjolenza abbażi tal-ġeneru u vjolenza domestika jirċievu servizzi psikosoċjali u legali kif ukoll il-protezzjoni meħtieġa. Barra minn hekk, il-Ministeru għall-Akkomodazzjoni Soċjali

the opportunity to leave their homes rather than remaining confined with their perpetrators.

In addition, several government entities and non-governmental organisations launched helplines to broaden the support available to victims of GBV and DV during the restrictive measures introduced during the pandemic. Helplines were set up by the Ministry for Education, the Foundation for Social Welfare Services, the Mental Health Services and the Women's Rights Foundation.

In August 2020, the Malta Police Force inaugurated a domestic violence virtual reality simulator at the Police Academy in Ta' Kandja to train Police Officers in raising their awareness on the matter and also equip them with the necessary skills when investigating such a crime.

National awareness-raising campaigns were coordinated by the Commission on Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence through the dissemination of informative material such as posters, leaflets and business cards with the contact numbers of service providers to pharmacies, supermarkets, grocers, banks, local councils, police stations and healthcare centres across Malta and Gozo. Radio clips with informative messages were also aired on several radio stations as part of the 'COVID awareness-raising campaign'.

Furthermore, through the EU co-funded project 'Breaking the Cycle of Violence', the Commission also coordinated a campaign with messages in various languages to be used on bus shelters across Malta and Gozo. Since social media usage has drastically increased during this time, the campaign was mainly focused on online sources and opted for online newspapers as its medium. Two messages were identified:

"Are you a victim of domestic violence? Call now on 179 for help."

"Asking for help does not make you weak. Make the call on 179 for help."

Through another EU co-funded project, 'GBV-SO Improving Support Structures for Victims

F'Awwissu 2020, il-Forza tal-Pulizija ta' Malta inawgurat simulatur tar-realtà virtwali tal-vjolenza domestika fl-Akkademja tal-Pulizija f'Ta' Kandja biex tħarreġ lill-Uffiċjali tal-Pulizija biex titqajjem is-sensibilizzazzjoni tagħhom dwar il-kwistjoni u biex jiġu mgħammra wkoll bil-ħiliet meħtieġa meta jinvestigaw reat bħal dan.

Kampanji nazzjonali t'għarfien ġew ikkoordinati mill-Kummissjoni dwar il-Vjolenza Abbażi tal-Ġeneru u l-Vjolenza Domestika permezz tat-tqassim ta' materjal informattiv bħal kartelluni, fuljetti u biljetti tal-viżta bin-numri ta' kuntatt tal-fornituri ta' servizz lil spiżeriji, supermarkits, ħwienet tal-merċa, banek, kunsilli lokali, stazzjonijiet tal-pulizija u ċentri tal-kura tas-saħħa madwar Malta u Għawdex. Siltiet tar-radju b'messaġġi informattivi xxandru wkoll fuq diversi stazzjonijiet tar-radju bħala parti mill-"kampanja t'għarfien tal-COVID".

Barra minn hekk, permezz tal-proġett kofinanzjat tal-UE "Inkissru ċ-Ċiklu ta' Vjolenza", il-Kummissjoni kkoordinat ukoll kampanja b'messaġġi f'diversi lingwi li għandha tintuża fix-xelters tal-karozzi tal-linja madwar Malta u Għawdex. Ladarba l-użu tal-midja soċjali żdied b'mod drastiku matul dan iż-żmien, il-kampanja kienet iffokata l-aktar fuq sorsi onlajn u għażlet gazzetti onlajn bħala l-midjum tagħha. Ġew identifikati żewġ messaġġi:

"Inti vittma ta' vjolenza domestika? Ċempel issa

of Gender-Based Violence', the Commission in collaboration with SOS Malta and Victim Support Malta created several posters to address gender-based violence and domestic violence during the COVID-19 situation. The aim of this campaign was to raise awareness about how homes might not be safe for all during the lockdown period and thus encouraging persons experiencing abuse to seek help and report. These posters were translated into different languages namely Maltese, English, Italian, Serbian and French. The campaign also targeted bystanders such as neighbours, relatives and co-workers to take a stand and not turn a blind eye to violence.

Thus, during the pandemic restrictive measures, that is, between March and June 2020, government entities and NGOs working in the field of GBV and DV ensured that while abiding by safety measures, services were still made available to those seeking help. Various awareness-raising campaigns have also helped in spreading information and knowledge on services as well as to pass on the message of zero tolerance to violence.

L-għan ta' din il-kampanja kien li jitqajjem għarfien dwar kif id-djar jistgħu ma jkunux sikuri għal kulħadd waqt il-perjodu ta' lockdown u għaldaqstant hegġet lil persuni li jesperjenzaw abbuż biex ifittxu għajnuna u jirrappurtaw. Dawn il-kartelluni ġew tradotti f'lingwi differenti, b'mod partikolari l-Malti, l-Ingliz, it-Taljan, is-Serb u l-Franċiż. Il-kampanja kienet immirata wkoll lejn persuni fil-qrib bħal ġirien, qraba u kollegi biex jjieħdu pożizzjoni u ma jagħlqux għajnejhom għall-vjolenza.

Għaldaqstant, matul il-mizuri restrittivi tal-pandemija, jiġifieri bejn Marzu u Ġunju 2020, entitajiet tal-gvern u NGOs li jaħdmu fil-qasam tal-GBV u d-DV żguraw li filwaqt li kienu osservati l-mizuri ta' sikurezza, is-servizzi xorta waħda kienu disponibbli għal dawk li fittxew l-għajnuna. Diversi kampanji ta' sensibilizzazzjoni għenu wkoll fit-tixrid ta' informazzjoni u għarfien dwar servizzi kif ukoll biex jgħaddu l-messaġġ ta' tolleranza zero għall-vjolenza.

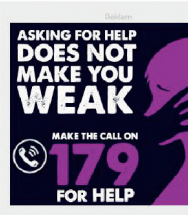



E. List of expected outcomes for 2021-2022

1. Monthly interministerial committee meetings to discuss and monitor the implementation of the strategy;
2. Quarterly meetings between NGOs and the interministerial committee to discuss service provision and policy development;
3. Quarterly awareness-raising campaigns on various themes in collaboration with the main stakeholders and NGOs;
4. Quarterly dissemination of information leaflets in various languages to schools, law courts, health centres, hospitals, community centres and hospitals in Malta and Gozo and district police stations;
5. Two annual progress reports on the implementation of the strategy;
6. Design and delivery of four specialised bespoke training programmes for professionals following training needs analysis;
7. Two in-service courses for professionals working directly in the field of GBV and DV;
8. Four information sessions with media houses and journalists;
9. Development of guidelines and/or protocols to address:
 - a. The need for multi-agency coordination and cooperation;
 - b. The implementation of MARAM;
 - c. The need for data collection across service providers;
 - d. Preventive action and risk assessment for educators and healthcare professionals to address all forms of violence including forced marriage and FGM;
 - e. Victim protection and support at all stages (from filing a police report, to seeking psycho-social support and legal counsel, to law courts);
 - f. Procedures of consent when providing support services and counselling for children witnessing violence; and
 - g. The coordination of specialised services for victims of rape and sexual assault in hospitals.

F. Monitoring and Evaluation

At the end of each quarter covered by this document, the Commission on Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence will draw up a report focusing on progress achieved in terms of implementation. The report will be discussed within the Interministerial Committee, and feedback taken on board. An annual report will be generated on the progress of the action plan and will be presented to the Minister responsible for gender equality.

Furthermore, recommendations put forward by GREVIO may lead to additional policy measures during the implementation period of this strategy and action plan.
